

Select from the list of event descriptions below to use on your plot diagram chart. Be sure to write the complete response on the chart. These events are not in any particular order.

Left at the grave, Scrooge promises to change and keep Christmas.

Scrooge will have dinner at his nephew's.

Ghost of Past shows Scrooge memories which bring warmth and sadness of regret.

Meets Adam and sends him to purchase the prize turkey for the Cratchits.

True to his word, Scrooge gives Bob Cratchit a raise in pay.

POV – Marley's Ghost (narrator) and the dialogue of the characters.

Scrooge offers to care for Tiny Tim, and was true to his word "keeping" Christmas.

Scrooge donates to the poor with back payments.

Initial Conflict – Scrooge says that someone owes him money and he will collect even on Christmas Eve.

Scrooge is surprised by the manner in which others see him, especially those who send him a toast.

Sees Jacob Marley as a doorknocker and later discovers that Marley is sending 3 spirits as a warning.

A ghostly mood on a cold, foggy Christmas Eve.

Ghost of Future shows Scrooge the events surrounding his death and how others think of him.
