- RL.7 Standard One: Cite several pieces textual evidence to support analysis of what the text says explicitly as well as inferences drawn from the text.
- 1. Cite (verb) to provide a quote from the passage as evidence of support; to provide proof in the way of a quote. Quotation marks would be necessary.
- 2. Textual Evidence (noun) the details found in the passage; the facts
- 3. Support (verb) to back up with evidence; defends; verifies; confirms; agrees with, certifies
- 4. Analysis (noun) to break down into basic parts and examine; findings based on observation; conclusion; investigation based on studies
- 5. Text (noun) passage; article, wording
- 6. Explicitly (adjective) stated clearly; well-developed and leaving no questions
- 7. Inferences –(noun) guess; speculate; imply
- 8. Drawn (verb) to take or pull-out of a passage
